# Hand Shaped

*Latin: Palmate*

*Like the palm of a hand.*

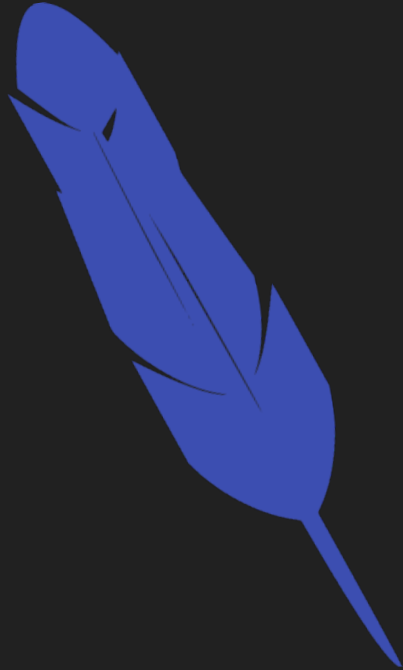

# Feather Shaped

*Latin: Pinnate*

*From the Latin “pinna,” meaning feather*



# Heart Shaped

*Latin: Cordate*



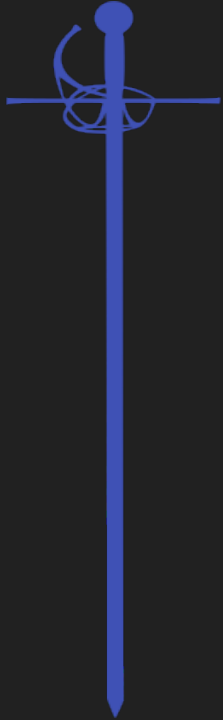
# Egg Shaped

*Latin: Ovoid, meaning “egg”*



# Lance Shaped

*Latin: Lanceolate*



# Compound Leaves

*Made up of many leaflets joined to one main leaf stalk.*

## **Pinnate-Compound**

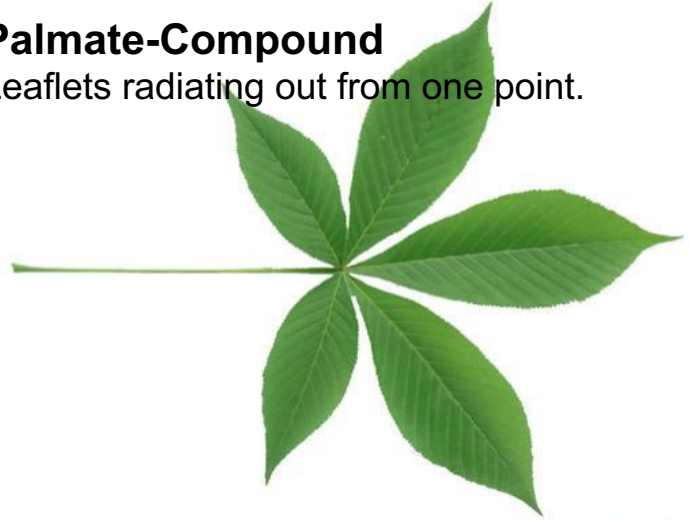
Leaflets on opposite sides of leaf stalk.
