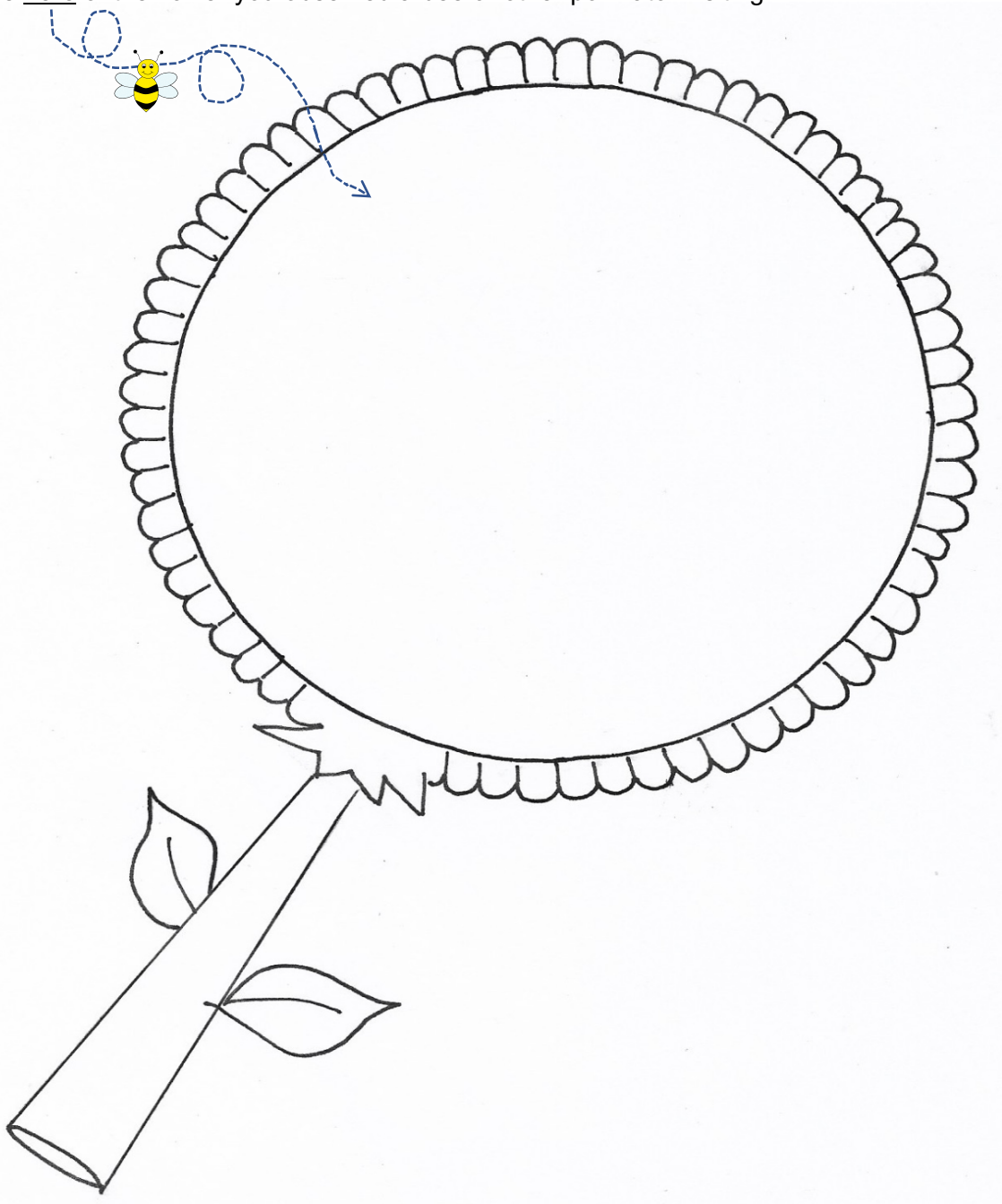

	Eastern Carpenter Bee <i>Xylocopa virginica</i> <i>Length: 23 mm</i> <i>Shiny black abdomen. Spot on thorax.</i>		
	Common Eastern Bumble Bee <i>Bombus impatiens</i> <i>Length: 15-25 mm</i> <i>Fuzzy abdomen with a yellow or brown belt.</i>		
	European Honey Bee <i>Apis mellifera</i> <i>Length: 10-15mm</i> <i>Striped honey colored abdomen is common, but the abdomen can also be quite dark.</i>		
	Leaf Cutter Bee <i>Megachile spp.</i> <i>Length: 10-15mm</i> <i>Striped black abdomen. Scopa on underside of abdomen.</i>		
	Striped Sweat Bee <i>Agapostemon spp.</i> <i>Length: 10-12mm</i> <i>Males have a yellow and black striped abdomen. Females have either a brown abdomen or a green abdomen.</i>		
	Pure Green Sweat Bee <i>Augochlora pura</i> <i>Length: 8mm</i> <i>Shiny green thorax and abdomen.</i>
