Height: Small, ornamental, specimen;
15'-20' in twenty years, up to 25'
in 30 years

Growth: Moderate growth rate

Width: 15'-30' spread

Light: Full sun or partial-sun

Water: Low

Soil: Prefers moist; well-drained soil

Shape: Round

Leaves: Showy red leaves in the fall

Flowers: Showy, white flowers in spring

Fruit: Edible dark purple berries in late-
summer
