



2024 CORPORATE IMPACT

In 2024, over 1,100 volunteers from 28 corporate partners joined NYRP in the field. Together we built new gardens, cared for cherished parkland, and hosted public community events across the five boroughs. *Thank you for your partnership supporting NYC's vital green spaces!*

New York Restoration Project – NYC's only citywide conservancy dedicated specifically to serving low-income communities – is committed to bringing the **health, social, nutritional, environmental, and educational benefits** of green spaces to all New Yorkers.

Our portfolio of parks and community gardens provides 85 acres of recreational green space to the more than 1.6 million New Yorkers living within a 10-minute walk of them, and every year we create about a dozen new gardens for community partners in all five boroughs.

We could not build, maintain, and activate these spaces without the philanthropic partnership and enthusiastic volunteer efforts of our many valued corporate partners.

In 2024, more than 1,100 volunteers donated over 3,700 hours towards the care and construction of urban green spaces, as well as the hosting of important community programming in our parks and gardens. We are deeply grateful for your partnership in our work and look forward to another impactful season in 2025.

NEW YORK CITY PARKS

Highbridge Park, Sherman Creek Park, and the Harlem River Greenway provide the communities of Northern Manhattan with 80 acres of open space while also serving as important platforms for nature-based climate adaptation. In 2024, volunteers helped NYRP staff remove over **3,200 pounds of trash** and nearly **10,000 pounds of invasive species**, refresh nature paths, reinforce our Living Shoreline, and plant over **1,750 native trees, shrubs, and perennials**.



COMMUNITY GARDENS

NYRP's community gardens stretch from Staten Island to Queens and from South Brooklyn to the North Bronx. Volunteer support was invaluable in ensuring each space remained **clean, welcoming, and accessible** to the diverse communities these gardens serve. Our corporate partners weeded, watered, mulched, made pathways ADA-accessible, rebuilt raised beds, and much more.



GARDENS FOR THE CITY

Through our popular GFTC program, corporate volunteers helped build and renovate a wide array of green spaces in all five boroughs including **public schools** in The Bronx and Queens, a public **health clinic** in East Harlem, a grassroots **events space** in Staten Island, an **urban farm** on The Bronx's Grand Concourse, and many more. In total, their efforts created over **1,800 square feet** of new growing space – enough to grow up to **1,300 pounds of produce** annually.



COMMUNITY EVENTS

Each of NYRP's green spaces is activated with free programming geared towards the interests of their communities. In 2024, our corporate volunteers supported **back to school giveaways** in Brooklyn, Queens, and The Bronx; **tree giveaways** in The Bronx and Queens; and NYRP's annual **Fall Fest harvest celebration** at Sherman Creek Park in Northern Manhattan.
