Access to nature improves lives. For 30 years, New York Restoration Project has lessened the disparity in park and garden access across New York City thanks to our community of supporters.

This year has been one of our busiest to date. Halfway through, we've already distributed and planted **thousands of trees** and shrubs; picked up **tons of trash**; built entirely **new green spaces**; and welcomed **hundreds of volunteers** into our parks and gardens. **Here's a look at what we've done so far in 2025** ➔

Built **3 new green spaces** with community partners

Hosted **56 programs** for **more than 1,800 people**

- Celebrating our 30th Anniversary achievements including removing **more than 6 million pounds of trash** (*almost 10 Statues of Liberty*) since 1995.
