2025 CORPORATE IMPACT

In 2025, over 650 volunteers from 19 corporate partners joined NYRP in the field. Together we built new gardens, cared for cherished parkland, and hosted public community events across the five boroughs. *Thank you for your partnership supporting NYC's vital green spaces!*

New York Restoration Project – NYC's only citywide conservancy dedicated specifically to serving underprivileged communities – is committed to bringing the **health, social, nutritional, environmental, and educational benefits** of green spaces to all New Yorkers.

Our portfolio of parks and community gardens provides 85 acres of recreational green space to the more than 1.6 million New Yorkers living within a 10-minute walk of them, and every year we build and refurbish new gardens for community partners across the city.

We could not build, maintain, and activate these spaces without the philanthropic partnership and enthusiastic volunteer efforts of our many valued corporate partners.

In 2025, more than **650 volunteers** donated **over 1,900 hours** towards the care and construction of urban green spaces, as well as the hosting of important community programming in our parks and gardens. We are deeply grateful for your partnership in our work and look forward to another impactful season in 2026.

NEW YORK CITY PARKS

Highbridge Park, Sherman Creek Park, and the Harlem River Greenway provide the communities of Northern Manhattan with 80 acres of open space while also serving as important platforms for nature-based climate adaptation. In 2025, volunteers helped NYRP remove over **1,800 pounds of trash** and nearly **10,000 pounds of invasive vegetation**, blaze brand new nature trails, steward our Living Shoreline, install **7 rain gardens** for flood control, and plant over **900 native trees, shrubs, and perennials**.



COMMUNITY GARDENS

NYRP's community gardens stretch from Staten Island to Queens and from South Brooklyn to the North Bronx. Volunteer support was invaluable in ensuring each space remained **clean, welcoming, and accessible** to the diverse communities these gardens serve. Our corporate partners weeded, watered, mulched, made pathways ADA-accessible, rebuilt raised beds, cared for street trees, planted pollinator-friendly perennials, and much more.



GARDENS FOR THE CITY

Every year, corporate volunteers provide indispensable assistance as we build and renovate green spaces for community partners through our **Gardens for the City** program. In 2025, over 200 volunteers joined us at La Finca Del Sur, a large urban farm in the South Bronx, to install 72 new raised beds, construct picnic benches and shade structures, and make other improvements in support of enhanced food production, education, and community gatherings.



COMMUNITY EVENTS & TREE GIVEAWAYS

Each of NYRP's green spaces is activated with free programming geared towards the interests of their communities. In 2025, our corporate volunteers supported **back to school giveaways** in Brooklyn, The Bronx, and Staten Island; **tree giveaways** in The Bronx and Queens; and NYRP's annual **Fall Fest harvest celebration** at Sherman Creek Park in Northern Manhattan.
